The students will be creating a power point presentation in which they will establish whether they will be a leader for Ancient Greece or Ancient Rome. They will display their findings they researched from the essential questions they asked and explain their reasons for choosing the country they did. They will then present their final product to the class using a smart board. The student will have already been introduced to many civilizations prior to starting this research and power point.

Steps for the Learning Activity:

First, students will be watching United Streaming Videos about Ancient Greece and Ancient Rome.

Then, students will be reading articles, books, and lessons in their social studies text about Ancient Rome and Ancient Greece.

After the videos and reading lessons students will be taken to the computer lab to use the Internet to investigate major turning points in the history of Ancient Greece and Rome to determine in which country they would rather be a leader.

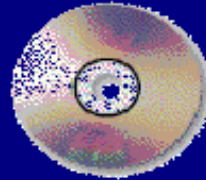

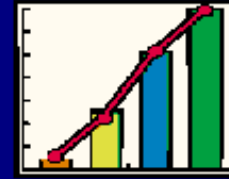

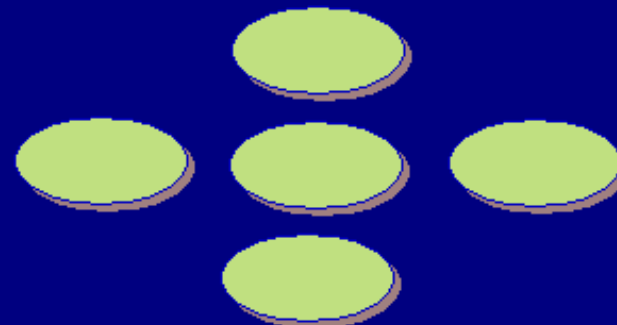
